The board took action on the following:

- The board approved the appointments of Patrick Miller as the Principal of Malibu High School, Melisa Andino as the Principal of the new Malibu Middle School, and Deanna Sinfield as the Director of Special Education (all beginning 2019-20).

The board discussed the following:

- As a follow-up to the lag (outcomes) and lead (predictive) data on student achievement presented this past fall, Ed Services shared lead data from Quarter 3 related to our district's FASTbridge universal literacy screening assessment for elementary grades, the rates of non-passing grades among secondary math students, participation rates in our district's reintroduction of interim assessments for ELA and math in all grades, as well as attendance data and suspension rates.
