On December 20, 2013, the Santa Monica-Malibu USD submitted – and the EPA accepted as modified per Dr. Patrick Wilson's December 20, 2013 email correspondence -- the District's work plan which included sampling to evaluate conditions on the Malibu HS campus after the implementation of Best Management Practices (BMPs).

On January 3, 2014, the District also submitted to the EPA sampling data that was collected *prior* to the implementation of the BMPs. While the data submitted on January 3 was not part of the accepted work plan, the EPA did review the air concentration measurements and noted that the results were all at reported PCB concentration below the EPA's acceptable level for Schools at 0.2ug/m3 for air and were within the EPA's acceptable risk range for residential exposure, including the maximum concentration of PCBs in air.

The District has now received air sampling data that was collected *after* the implementation of BMPs. As was done on January 3, 2014, we are submitting this sampling for your review on two attached documents (Post-BMP Report No. 8240 (Rooms 2 and 9) and Post-BMP Report No. 8241). I understand that this post-BMP sampling is not part of the accepted work plan, but your expertise in reviewing this data would be greatly appreciated.

To assist in the analysis, the sample numbers and locations for the post-BMP air sampling are as follows:
