Dear Parent:

The Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District **does not** provide medical insurance coverage for student injuries and injuries to others caused by your student. This means that you may be responsible for the medical bills if your child gets hurt during school activities. Applications for low cost accident insurance for students are available at your child's school. Please ask the office for an application. Many coverage options are available. If your child is currently covered by medical insurance, this student insurance may also be helpful in paying charges not covered by the other insurance (i.e., deductibles and co-payments).
