- Ed Services staff presented information and next steps related to a training they attended in Boston with the National Network of Partnership Schools (NNPS), which brings together schools, districts, and states together to examine research-based approaches to organize and sustain excellent programs of family and community involvement designed to increase student success in school.
- The board discussed suggested changes to policies and regulations associated with: District Advisory Committees; Budget; Sale and Disposal of Books, Equipment and Supplies; Bids; Advanced Placement; Guidance / Counseling Services; Title I Programs; and Continuation Education.
