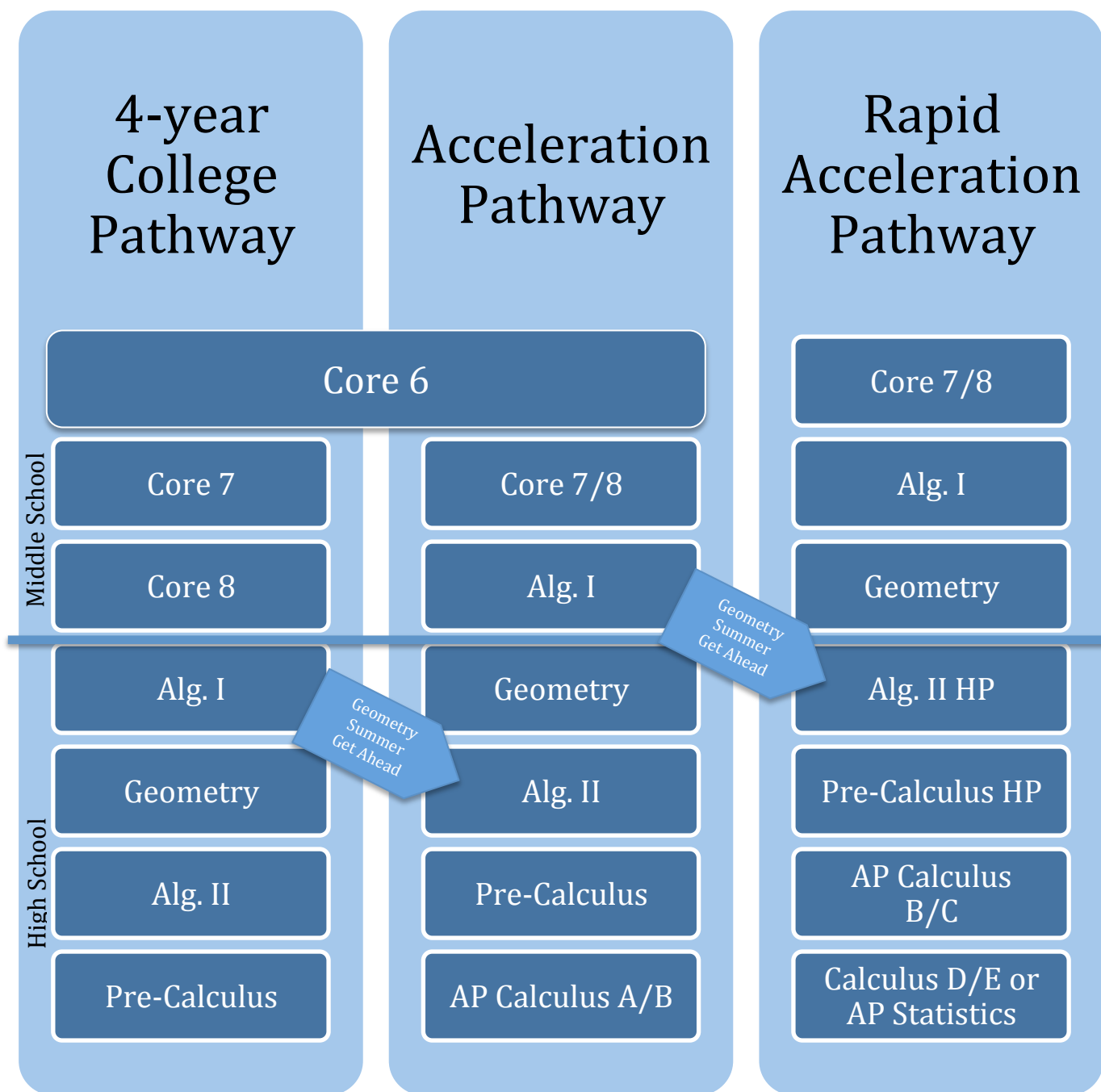


## Middle School Math Course Placement Criteria for 2015-16

While the demands of the Common Core State Standards have significantly increased the rigor of all middle school math courses, the district continues to offer opportunities for high achieving students to accelerate in math to ensure the best fit for their needs. Below are the three pathways available to incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Grade students.



Students can take "Get Ahead" Geometry in summer school after 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> to provide additional acceleration points.

UC/CSU a-g minimum requirements are Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II. A fourth year of math is strongly encouraged.

**AP Statistics** and **Statistics** provide an additional high-level math for interested students.
