

McKinley Lesson Link Cycle 1 Lesson Plan
2nd Grade Team: Questioning

Teach:

The teacher will remind the class we've been reading and discussing the story A Trip To The Firehouse. Today we're going to continue looking at the story A Trip To The Firehouse while focusing on asking appropriate questions to better understand the story. Just like we did for Jay The Mailman you are going to reread A Trip To The Firehouse in small parts and write appropriate questions that can be answered after reading the story.

Guided Practice:

Teacher will ask the class to remember the story Jay The Mailman and discuss appropriate and inappropriate questions about the story. Remember - being able to think of appropriate questions about a story helps you to better understand it. Let me show you examples of appropriate and inappropriate questions from Jay The Mailman. The teacher will then show a poster with different examples of appropriate and inappropriate questions about the story. The teacher will then briefly discuss why they are either appropriate or inappropriate based on looking back at the story to find the answer.

Application:

The teacher will read the specific pages (270 - 273), (274 - 275), and (276 - 277) and have the students write appropriate questions for those sections in A Trip To The Firehouse. The teacher will explain how to complete the question worksheet. Students will be told to read specific pages from the story and ask an appropriate question based on that particular passage. The teacher will remind students to use correct question words, capitalization, and punctuation rules when writing their questions. The teacher will ask if there are any questions and then circulate as the students complete the assessment. Student work will be collected for the teachers to analyze and discuss.
