### The board took action on the following:

- The board appointed a new member to the Financial Oversight Committee (FOC) to fill a vacancy.
- The board adopted an annual resolution in honor of Week of the School Administrator, which is October 8-14 this year. This recognition celebrates our district's administrators and their dedication to the academic success and personal well-being of our students.
- The board held its annual public hearing and adopted a resolution on the sufficiency of instructional materials.
