Assembly Bill 361 (9/2021) added section 54953(e) to the Government Code, authorizing a local agency to use teleconferencing without complying with the teleconferencing requirements imposed by the Ralph M. Brown Act during a declared state of emergency under specific scenarios. The law remains in effect until January 1, 2024. Due to the state of emergency proclaimed by Governor Newsom in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and its highly contagious variants, and as authorized by per AB 361 and SMMUSD Board of Education Resolution No. 21-08, the November Health and Safety District Advisory Committee meeting will be held virtually.

COVID-19 Testing & Vaccination

- <u>Are you up to date with your Covid-19 Vaccine</u>? Receiving your initial vaccine series gives you more freedom to work, visit certain venues and, in some cases, travel with fewer restrictions. But getting up to date with all recommended COVID-19 vaccine doses, including a booster dose (when eligible), provides the best protection against COVID-19 and variants like Omicron and Delta. <u>Schedule your vaccine or booster</u> <u>appointment</u>
- <u>Weekly Site Covid Testing</u>: Last day for High School Weekly Covid testing will be May 27th. Last day for Elementary Weekly Covid Testing will be June 3rd.
- <u>Eight Free Covid-19 Home Test Kits per Household Available</u> The White House announced on Monday that 8 more Covid-19 Home Test Kits are now available at no charge as part of a government program.

How to order:

It only takes a couple of minutes to order the kits: Visit <u>www.COVIDTests.gov</u>, enter your contact information and mailing address, and select "Place My Order."

If you don't have internet access or need additional help placing an order, call 1-800-232-0233 between 8 a.m. and midnight EST, any day of the week.

No ID, credit card or health insurance information is required. You can also choose to share your email address if you want tracking updates on your order. And it's completely free — there is no shipping charge.

Kits should ship <u>within 7-12 days</u> of ordering. Orders within the contiguous United States will be sent as a First-Class parcel, while shipments to Alaska, Hawaii, U.S. territories and overseas military and diplomatic addresses will be sent through Priority Mail.
