





Phrase

A group of words that go together and are easy to remember


Follow the steps to create your own strong password.

| 1. | Start with a phrase . Think of a quote or group of words that will be easy to remember. | Example: <i>There's no way I'm</i> eating that. |
|----|--|--|
| 2. | Write down just the first letter of each word in the phrase. | tnwiet |
| 3. | Capitalize some of the letters. | TnwieT |
| 4. | Add one or two memorable numbers . | TnwieT44 |
| 5. | Memorize it. Repeat your new password in your head so it sticks. | |




