We are aware that our guiding health agency, the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (LACDPH) aligned the protocols for modified quarantine with the state's protocols yesterday afternoon.

As has been stated publicly at recent school board meetings, we will be implementing this change and are working to make this adjustment as soon as possible.

This is great news for our students, families and staff, and a welcome change toward achieving our goal of ensuring in-person instruction, while continuing to prioritize the health and safety of our students and staff.

Our team is planning for this change and we will have an email with additional information to you by Monday with details and the expected start date of our implementation of this new protocol.
