SMMUSD remains steadfastly dedicated to maintaining positive school climates that promote student learning and development. School counselors are available at school for students who are feeling overwhelmed or fearful. Our district is committed to the education and welfare of students from all backgrounds.

We would like to remind our families that our enrollment and registration process only requires verification of local residency and does not require proof of citizenship or immigration status. Federal law prohibits us from asking for immigration status and the U.S. Supreme Court ruled in 1982 that no public school district has a basis to deny children access to education based on their immigration status.

The Immigrations and Customs Enforcement (ICE) policy of 2011 states that it will not conduct immigration enforcement activity at any sensitive location, which includes schools, without special permission by specific federal law enforcement officials, unless exigent circumstances exist.
