Criteria	Impact to Students	Losses and Gains	Amendments
<ol> <li>Extent of critical relationship to SMMUSD's mission, vision, shared values, capacities of students, LCAP goals</li> </ol>			
2. The degree that the package meets equity goals and provides for student differences, interests, and abilities, and provides resources to improve the quality of teaching, support services, capital equipment and facilities			
3. Extent of necessity to meet educational levels prescribed by state standards and other accrediting organizations, and inclusion of services necessary for efficient and effective operations
