Public Code of Conduct

The Superintendent's Budget Advisory Committee (SBAC) is operating based on guidelines consistent with other types of SMMUSD committees. The public is asked to maintain the same standards of respect, decency, restorative practices and cooperative engagement as SBAC members. The interest is not to silence, but to create a safe space that allows those who have been tasked with representing the broad spectrum of interests across SMMUSD to do so free of coercion or fear of retaliation or abuse of any kind. In order to allow SBAC members to conduct their business and carry out the Board's charge effectively and efficiently, we want to remind you of expectations (Code of Conduct) that have been set. Members of the public are requested to adhere to the following behaviors:

- Observe the meeting and not engage with SBAC members during the course of the meeting.
- Do not make verbal comments and attempt to participate in the process.
- Provide comments and questions through the SMMUSD *Let's Talk* website portal or in writing at SBAC meetings. Additionally, public comments are always welcome at Board of Education meetings.
- No photography, video or audio recording of materials, worksheets, or presentations.
 Presentations will be posted online following each meeting.
- Be respectful in the room and on all social media platforms regarding our work.
- Consider the potential impact any discussion of this topic on social media may cause during the process.
