Survey Goals

Staff were surveyed from Friday, June 26 – Thursday, July 2 to determine what percentage of staff would be able to return if in-person instruction resumed and what the corresponding child supervision need might be.

In an effort to gather input from families regarding the proposed models for the reopening of schools in Fall 2020 a survey was also administered to parents/guardians from Monday, July 6 - Sunday, July 12.

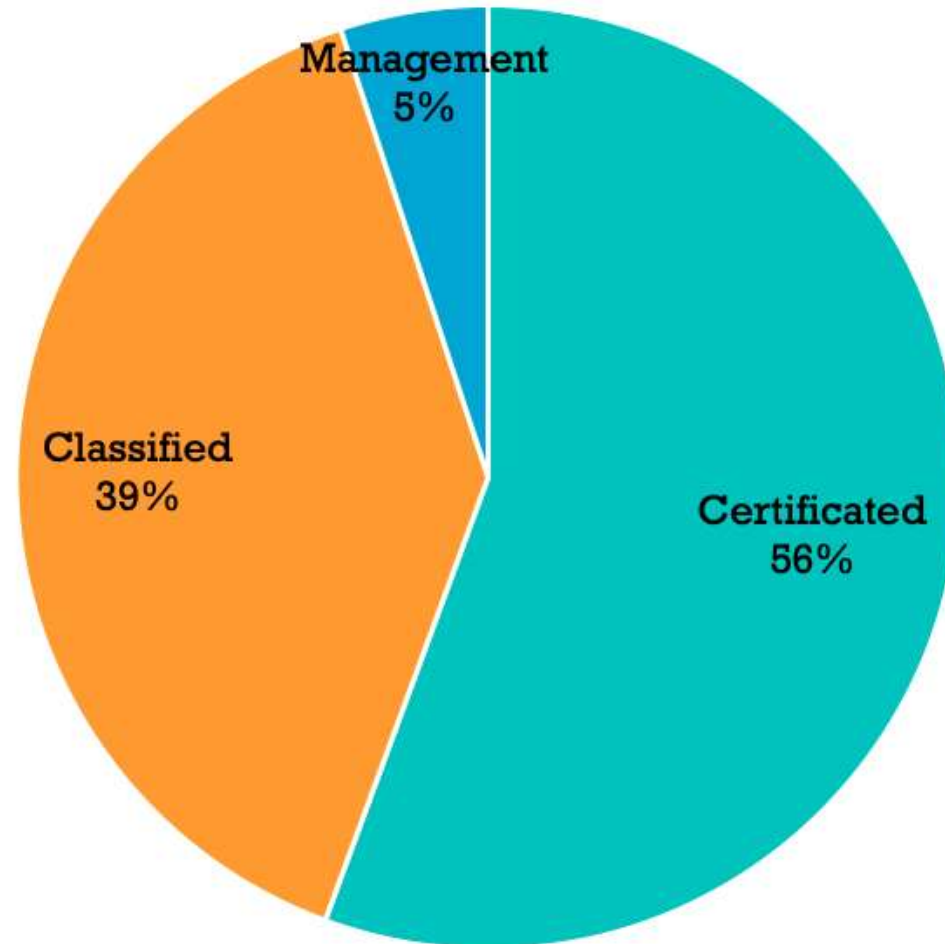

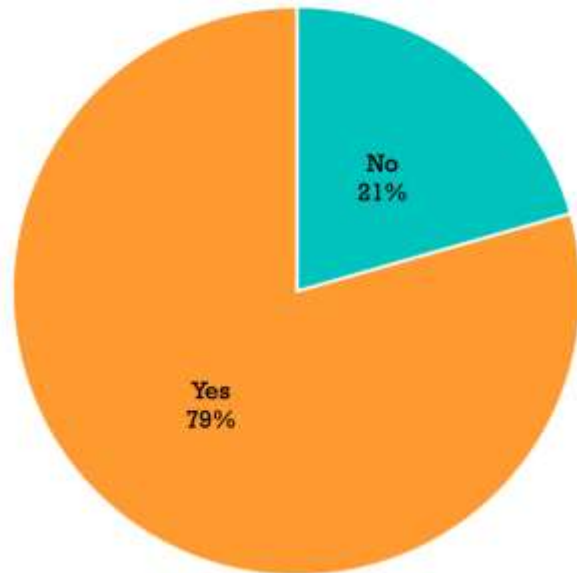
Which of the following best describes your role at SMMUSD?



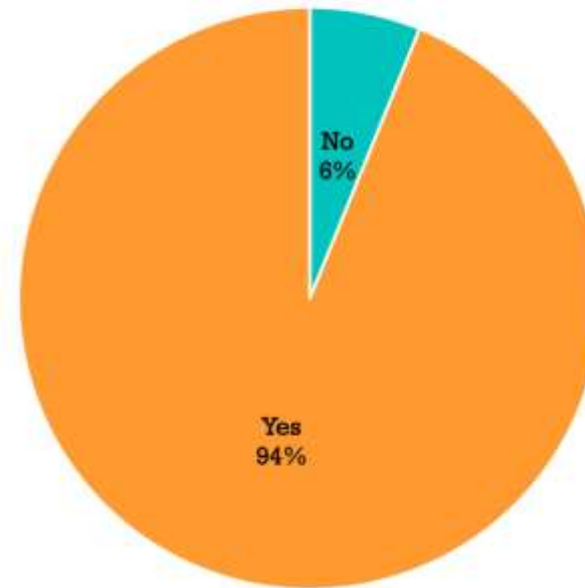
If needed, will you be able to return to work in-person?

Documentation might be required to demonstrate existing health condition for self or any dependents that would prevent staff member from providing in-person instruction

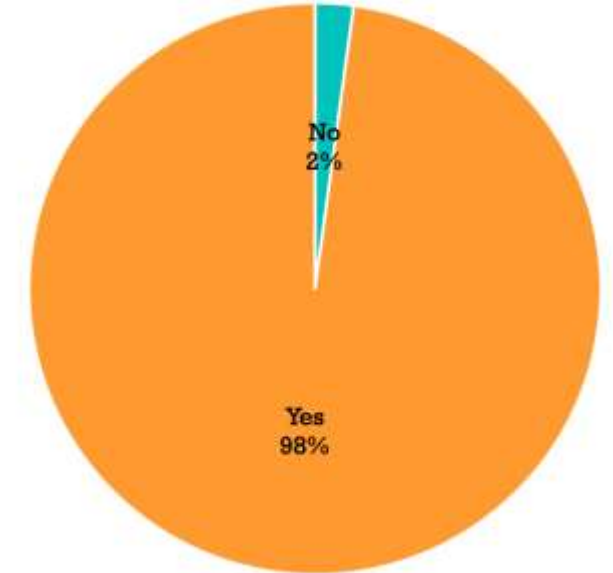
Certificated (N=505)



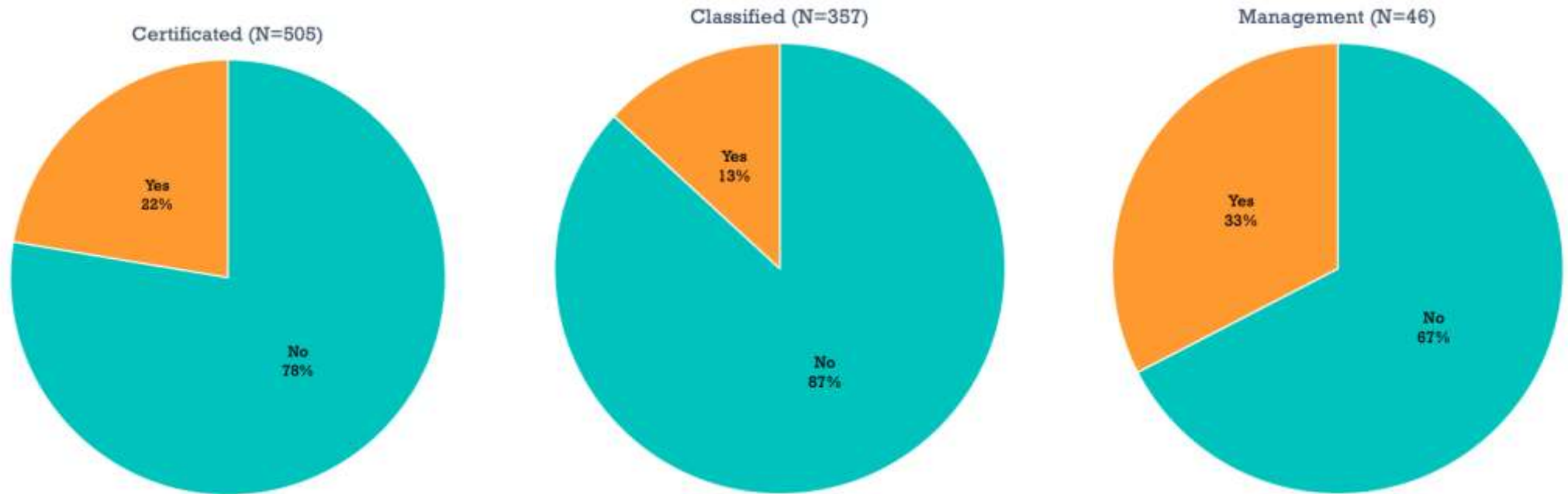
Classified (N=357)

Will you require district assistance with child supervision during school hours?



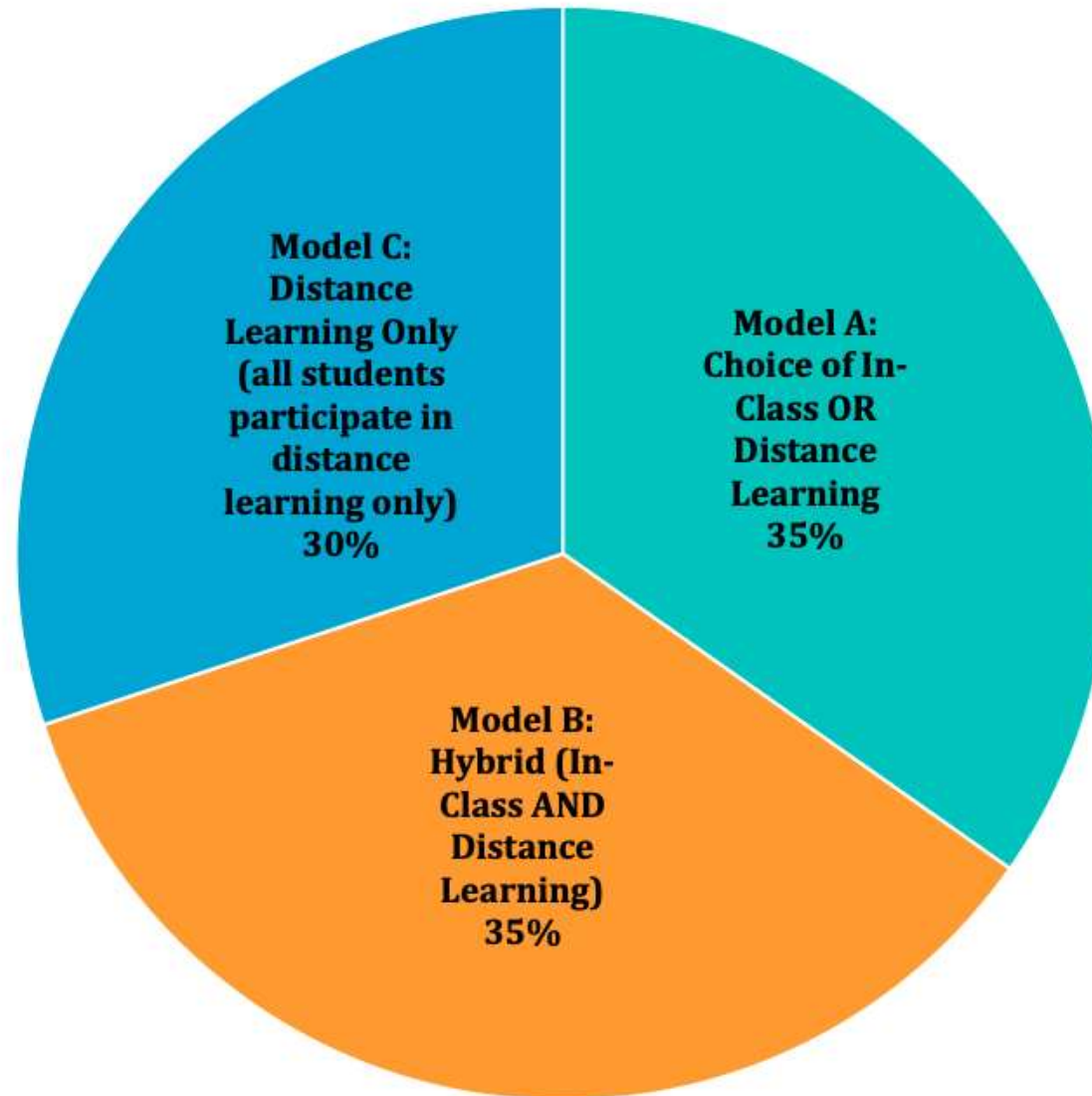
Out of the 908 staff who completed the survey, 175 said they will required district assistance with child supervision

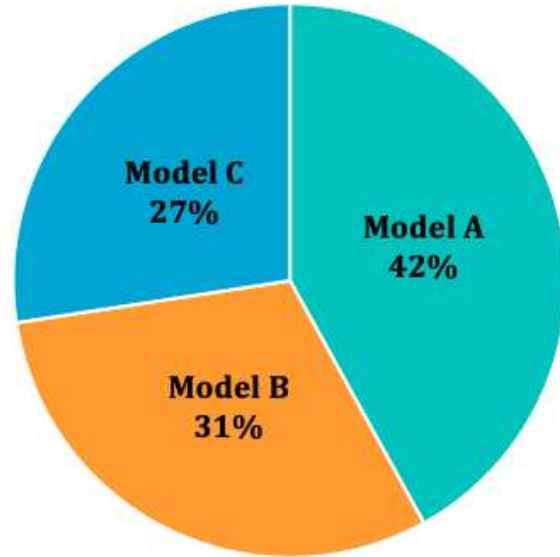

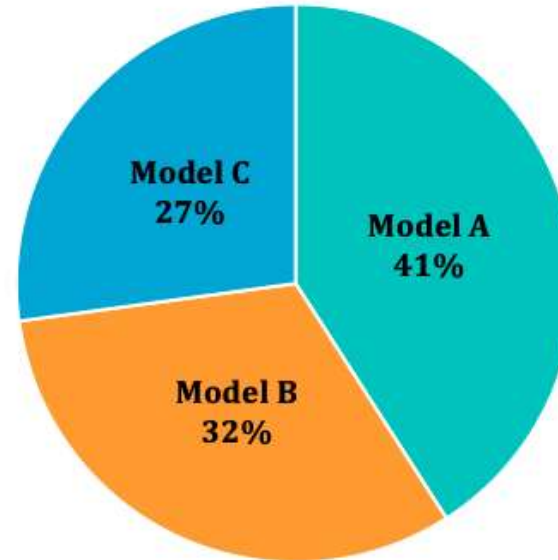


Which three models of instruction should the district provide? (By Grade Span)

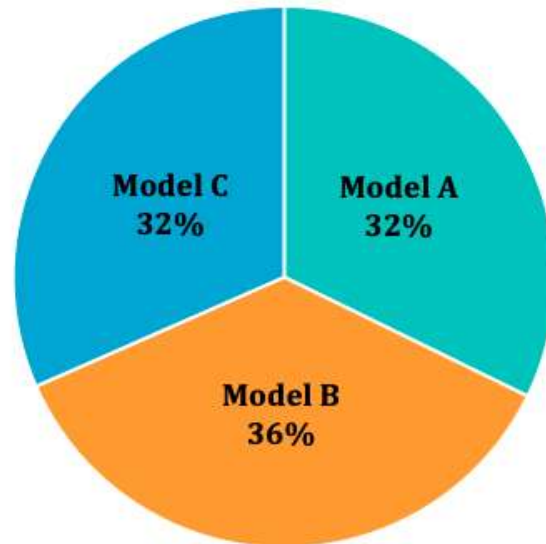

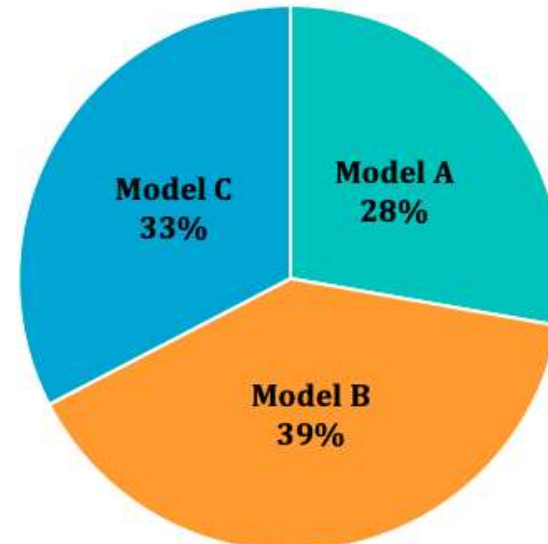

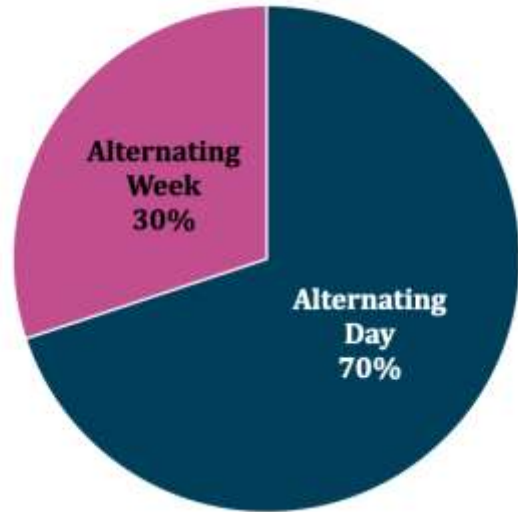


Which models of instruction should the district provide? (By Grade Span)

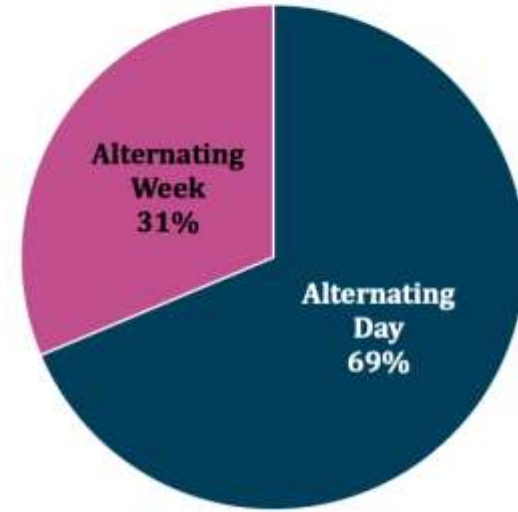


Which of the following hybrid models' weekly schedules do you prefer?

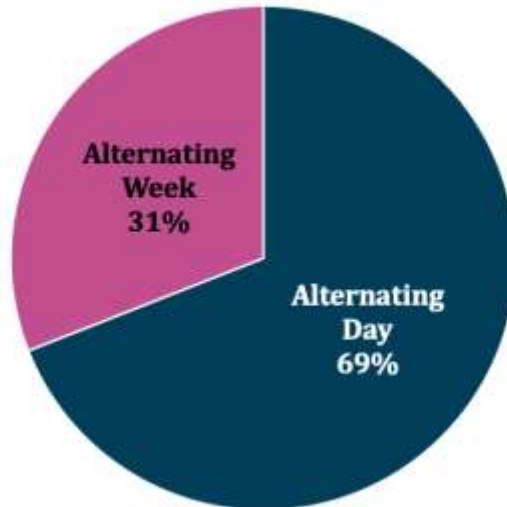

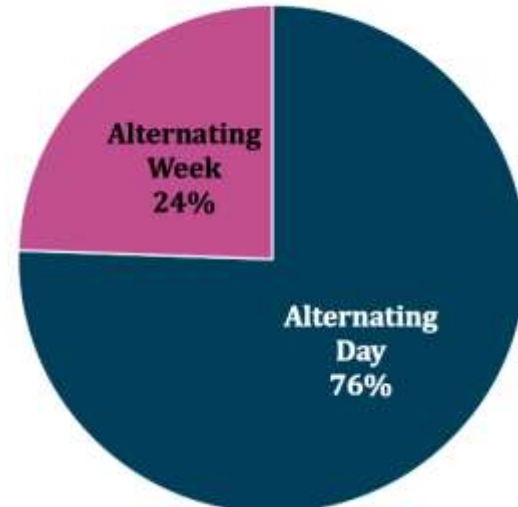

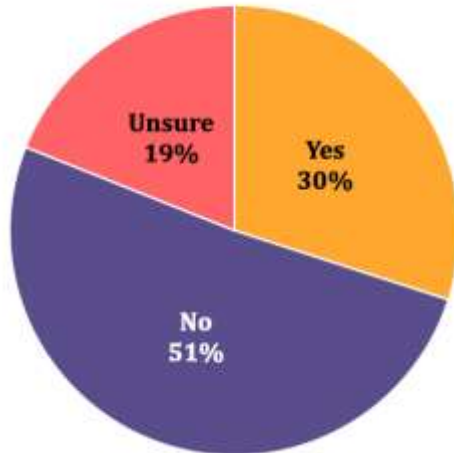

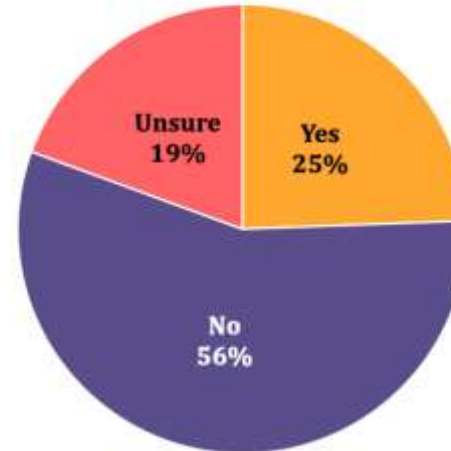
Will you require assistance with student supervision during school hours on days when your student is not scheduled to be on campus?

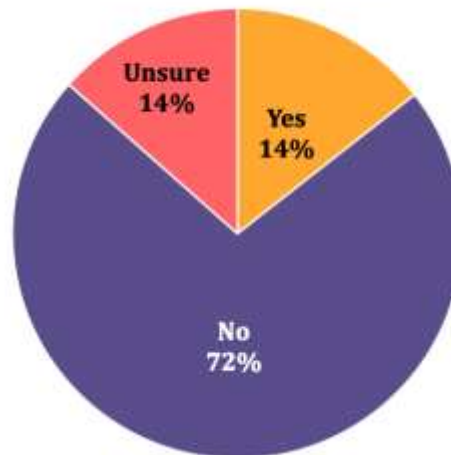
Grades TK-2 (N=1,878)



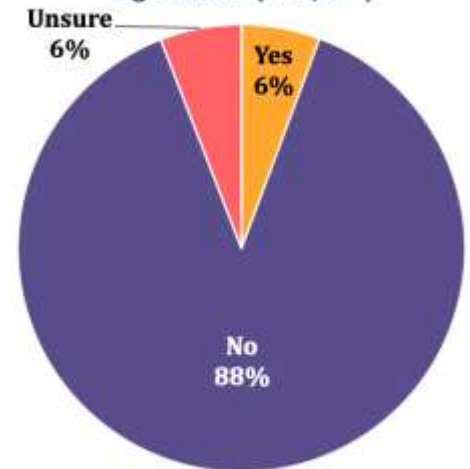
Grades 3-5 (N=2,195)
