

SBAC Guiding Principles

- 1. In order to assure alignment and impact, the Superintendent's Budget Advisory Committee Process will:
 - a. Be Student-Centered to Ensure Resources are Allocated in Ways to Best Serve Students.
 - b. Base resourcing decisions on the value for students.
 - c. Prioritize cost-effective strategies and programs that have the best outcomes for students.
- 2. Ensure Equity of Opportunity for All Students
 - a. Use an equity lens in making student-centered decisions across the continuum of learning by abilities, styles, and social determinants.
 - b. Make certain that per-pupil allocations are weighted by need.
- 3. Be Inclusive, Collaborative, and Transparent to Ensure Diverse Perspectives
 - a. Encourage collective approach through open and authentic dialogue.
 - b. Consider all costs in evaluating the cost of educating students.
 - c. Be clear on what actions are being funded and their intended outcomes.
- 4. Critically Re-examine Patterns of Spending
 - a. Review programs and be open to making challenging decisions to maximize student outcomes.
 - b. Consider all costs in evaluating the cost of educating students.
 - c. Champion decision-making driven by data and information based on evidence or promising practices.
- 5. Take a long-term approach
 - a. Use a comprehensive approach, considering all resources and expenses
 - b. Focus on long-term fiscal health.
