Dear John Muir Families,

Happy February! This month marks report card season. First semester report cards were distributed on Friday, February 7. At this point in the year, we want to see that students are making progress toward mastery. Not all areas have been addressed up to this point, and mastery is not expected until the end of the school year. Please be sure to read the teacher comments on the report card. Feel free to reach out to your child's teacher by email or phone to ask questions or share concerns.

Another way that we track student progress is through our work toward our site goal. We continue to focus on student use of evidence and academic language to support claims. Through the guidance of our School Leadership Team, we are in the midst of our second cycle of inquiry using math tasks to measure student progress. Grade-level teacher teams are implementing specific tools and strategies and will measure their effectiveness as it relates to students' ability to use evidence and academic language to explain their thinking on a common error analysis task in March. The student outcome data will be analyzed and compared with baseline data gathered in November 2019.

On another exciting note, all SMMUSD schools are launching new and improved websites this Friday, February 14! These enhanced sites will include colors and graphics reflective of the school site and buttons that link to our social media accounts and Peachjar flyers.
