We will be collecting formal dresses, formal wear such as tuxedos, dress suits, gently used shoes, fancy purses, jewelry, other formal attire accessories such as ties, bowties, and unopened cosmetics to provide to the students free of charge. This idea builds an inclusive community and also helps our planet by upcycling clothing and other items.

Take a look in your closet. There may be a dress that you wore in a wedding, or to a formal event, that you may unlikely to ever wear again. And how about a tuxedo, a suit or sports coat that just takes up too much room. Then it's time to donate to the Santa Monica High School Prom Boutique!

This is how it works: It's the Rent the Runway idea. All students shop our inventory for the dress or suit with the assistance from a volunteer personal shopper. The students borrow the outfit, clean it and return to us. A fun fact, each year we have had a lovely parent volunteer who tailors the outfits and a seamstress who works on the dresses and suits.
