PROJECT GREEN CHALLENGE*

OCTOBER 1-30, 2021

SMMUSD is proud to announce and promote the Project Green Challenge (PGC), a month-long international event hosting daily environmental challenges. Middle and high school students are eligible to sign up via the website www.projectgreenchallenge.com individually or as groups (up to four people). High school students who participate are eligible to win daily prizes and awards that include a trip to San Francisco and cash prizes up to \$5,000.

While middle school students are not eligible to receive prizes or awards through the international PGC event, **SMMUSD is hosting our own PGC** to provide Middle and High schoolers the chance to win cash prizes. Middle school and high school students will be separated into two different challenge groups, and both will submit their daily PGC assignments to our SMMUSD judges.

Three (3) winners from both the middle and high school levels will be announced in mid- November.; 1st place will receive \$100, 2nd place \$50 and 3rd place \$25 in VISA gift cards. That's right, high school students have the chance to win prizes through both the international Project Green Challenge as well as SMMUSD's Project Green Challenge.

SMMUSD PROJECT GREEN CHALLENGE RULES

*Daily challenge submissions must comply with the following criteria to be eligible:

- Both SMMUSD middle and high school students will follow the international PGC daily challenges and will email their submissions to **sustainability@smmusd.org**.
- Include student's name, school, grade and challenge title in each submission.
- Each international PGC challenge is posted at 6am each day and will remain live for 24 hours. Participants must complete challenge tasks and email their submissions during that time frame. (Some Challenges are two-day challenges and will allow 48 hours to complete). Entries received after 6am the following day will not be considered valid, unless otherwise noted.
- SMMUSD will follow the PGC point system for Challenge Task Options: Green, Greener and Greenest (see Judging / Scoring)
- All entries become the property of SMMUSD, which will hold publication rights for winning entries.

Judging / Scoring

- Three(3) winners will be announced for both Middle and High School levels mid-November.
- 1st place receives \$100, 2nd place \$50 and 3rd place \$25 in VISA gift cards.
- Winners will be determined by 1) quantity of submissions (1 submission = 1 point) and 2) Challenge Task option (green = 1 pt, greener = 2 pts, greenest = 3 pts). Challenge submissions will be judged on creativity, content accuracy, and relevance to topic, as determined by the Challenge judges.
- Winners will be recognized on the SMMUSD website and social media platforms (Instagram and Twitter).
