SPSA Goals reviewed:

Elissa makes a motion to adopt the goals as presented.

Goal 1: College/Career Readiness

MS Goal: 65% of students meet/exceed state standards as measured by CAASPP Math or other local measures (58% in 18-19)

MS Goal 2: 80% of students meet/exceed state standards as measured by CAASPP ELA or other local measures (72% 18-19)

Goal 2: English Language Development

Goal 1: 90% of EL students will improve 1 or more levels OR remain at level 4 as measured by ELPAC overall

Goal 2: 36% (5/14 students) will be redesignated as English Fluent Proficient based on multiple measures to include CAASPP, ELPAC, Course Grades, Teacher Input, and Parent Input.

Goal 3: School Climate

Goal 1: 65% of students will report either liking school or liking school very much as measured by student perception surveys (Student Engagement) (20-21 waiting on data, 19-20 62%, 18-19 55%, 6-12 42.2 in 17-18, 42.6% in 16-17)

Goal 2: 75% of students will report that they believe MMS is an inclusive community as measured by student survey
