Thank you for your understanding as I do my best to respond and communicate information as quickly as it is shared. I hope you all have received the detailed message tonight from Dr. Drati, Superintendent of Schools. Please read the information included in his important message. Some key information included:

- Schools will remain OPEN, unless direction is given to us by the Department of Public Health
- All field trips (day and overnight) will be cancelled
- Open House will be postponed
- Any evening meeting (PTA, ELAC, SSC) will also be cancelled for time being

For **Webster Elementary**, here is some site specific information:

1. **MATH FIELD DAY**- Friday, March 13th will be postponed.
2. **PROSPECTIVE PARENT TOUR**: Monday, March 16th cancelled.
3. **PTA GENERAL MEETING**: Friday, March 20th will be cancelled.
4. **FIELD TRIPS**: Tuesday, March 24th Kindergarten trips to the SB Zoo and Natural History Museum will be cancelled.

All other trips scheduled prior to spring break will be postponed/cancelled. Coordinating teachers will reach out to students and parents.

5. **JOG-A-THON**: March 26th will be postponed.
6. **SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL**: April 1st @ 3:15 a.m. will be cancelled.
7. **OPEN HOUSE**: Thursday, April 2nd will be postponed and rescheduled for a later date.
8. **YOSEMITE AND ASTRO CAMP**: April 27th-May 1st cancelled. Postponement may be an option depending on availability.
9. **IEPs and SST** meetings will still be held unless otherwise notified.

I want to acknowledge that we are a resilient community. Last year we suffered a natural disaster of immense scale and destruction, one that we continue to navigate together as a community. There have been other challenges throughout the year, and now this pandemic.
