

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
ON INTENTION OF SANTA MONICA-MALIBU UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT  
TO CONSIDER ENTERING INTO AN  
ENERGY SERVICES CONTRACT WITH FAMAND INC., DBA INDOOR  
ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEMS TO PROVIDE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF  
PHOTOVOLTAIC SYSTEMS AT VARIOUS DISTRICT SCHOOL SITES PURSUANT  
TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 4217.12 ET SEQ.**


**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** of the intention of the Governing Board of the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District ("District") to, pursuant to the terms of Government Code section 4217.12, consider entering into an energy services contract with Famand Inc., dba IES Environmental Systems, to provide design and construction of photovoltaic systems at various District school sites ("Agreement").

The Governing Board will consider facts and testimony to determine whether the Agreement is in the best interests of the District, whether the anticipated cost to the District for electrical energy or conservation services provided by the energy conservation facility under the Agreement will be less than the anticipated marginal cost to the District of electrical, or other energy that would have been consumed by the District in the absence of those purchases under the Agreement, and the suitability and effectiveness of installing photovoltaic systems at various District sites.

The time and place set for the public hearing is 5:30 PM which will take place at the District's Board Room located at 1651 16<sup>th</sup> Street, Santa Monica, California 90404 on the intention of the Governing Board of the District to consider entering into the Agreement on February 1, 2018 or as soon thereafter as practicable, at Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District 1651 16<sup>th</sup> Street, Santa Monica, California 90404.

At such time, the testimony of all interested persons for or against the proposed Agreement will be heard. Protests may be made orally or in writing. Any protest pertaining to the regularity or sufficiency of the proceedings shall be in writing and shall clearly set forth the irregularities and defects to which the objection is made. All written protests shall be filed with the Clerk of the District on or before the time set for the hearing. The District may waive any irregularities in the form or content of any written notice and at the hearing may correct minor defects in the proceedings. Written protests may be withdrawn, in writing, at any time before the conclusion of the hearing.
