Santa Monica High School Athletic Sportsmanship

All Santa Monica High School players, coaches, managers, sponsors and spectators are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner at all times. The Athletic Director has the authority to remove anyone from the event at any time for unsportsmanlike conduct. Any player, coach, manager, sponsor or spectator whose conduct is unbecoming or abusive shall leave the game premises. If warranted, the offending party shall be ejected from the game at the discretion of the officials and Athletic Director.

If necessary, a team may be forced to forfeit a game if unruly spectator does not vacate the premises.

Ejection Policy

Any participant (player, coach, spectator) who is ejected for making contact with an official or who is ejected for unsporting behavior directed toward an official, shall be subject to a non-appealable suspension from the next contest at that level and for all contests at any level (in that activity) until the Santa Monica High School administration uplifts the suspension. The Santa Monica High School Leadership may levy additional sanctions as they deem appropriate. The CIF staff reviews all ejection reports. Note: the requirement for all ejected students to complete the CIF Southern Section Sportsmanship course and the requirement for all ejected coaches to complete the CIF Southern Section Teaching and Modeling Behavior course prior to being reinstated remain in effect.
