The primary reason for the problem is the rising cost of operations coupled with the under funding of the programs by the State. The full day preschool program is most deficient in terms of operations cost to income. The elimination of this program along with the accompanying costs is a serious action, but a necessary part of bringing program costs in line with program income.
