When a member of the Staff presents an item, the Board may ask clarifying questions before the Public is heard on that item. Board discussion of the item will take place after hearing from the Public.

#### RECOMMENDATION NO. A.1

It is recommended that the Board of Education adopt Resolution Number 02-30: <a href="IMPLEMENTING CERTIFICATED LAYOFF">IMPLEMENTING CERTIFICATED LAYOFF</a> (TERMINATING SERVICES OF CERTIFICATED EMPLOYEES), ACTING UPON PROPOSED DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE AND PROVIDING DIRECTION TO ISSUE NOTIFICATIONS TO EMPLOYEES WHOSE SERVICES ARE TERMINATED.

COMMENT: The Superintendent is recommending to the Board of Education that take action on Resolution 02-30, pursuant to California Education Code Sections 44949 and 44955.

On March 6, 2003, this Board adopted Resolution Number 02-23 reducing or discontinuing particular kinds of services with respect to probationary and tenured certificated staff. On March 13, 2003, this Board adopted Resolution Number 02-25 reducing or discontinuing particular kinds of services with respect to emergency credentialed certificated staff.

Prior to March 15, 2003, the Superintendent's designated representative(s) served notices to the appropriate certificated employees, that it has been recommended that each of their services will not be required for the 2003-2004 school year, pursuant to Education Code Sections 44949 and 44955. These notices served upon the named certificated employees listed in the adopted resolutions, advised the employees that they could request a hearing before the Governing Board to determine if there was cause for not reemploying them for the 2003-2004 school year and that if they failed to timely request a hearing, that failure would constitute the waiver of the right to a hearing, and his/her services would accordingly be terminated pursuant to the recommendation.

Fifteen employees requested a hearing and certificated employee layoff proceedings accordingly have occurred pursuant to Sections 44955 and 44949 of the Education Code, with an Administrative Law Judge having held an evidentiary hearing and then submitting a proposed decision relating to those proceedings. On April 28 and 29, 2003, a hearing on the layoffs was conducted by an Administrative Law Judge pursuant to the California

Administrative Procedure Act, and a proposed decision was rendered and received by the District on May 7, 2003.

The employees listed were sent a copy of the proposed decision of the Administrative Law Judge via registered mail and advised of their right to attend the meeting of the Board in which the following Resolution would be adopted.

Subsequent to the adoption of this Resolution and prior to May 15th, the named employees must be sent via certified and regular mail, a copy of this Resolution and a letter notifying them of their termination, which becomes effective at the end of the 2002-03 school year.

It should be noted that since the Board's initial adoption of layoff resolutions, a number of layoff notices have been rescinded as a result of attrition in the certificated workforce. As attrition continues between now and year end, it is anticipated that additional layoff notices will be rescinded. Staff will keep the Board appraised of these changes as they occur.

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2003	this Board adopted Resolution Number – 02-23

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2003, this Board adopted Resolution Number – 02-25

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2003, and before March 15, 2003 the Superintendent served notice to this Board of his recommendation that the employees listed herein below receive notice that their services will not be required for the ensuing school year (2003-2004), pursuant to Education Code Sections 44949 and 44955; and

WHEREAS, on or before March 15, 2003, the Superintendent's designated representative(s) served notices to the appropriate certificated employees, including those listed below, that it has been recommended that each of their services will not be required for the 2003-2004 school year, pursuant to Education Code Sections 44949 and 44955;

WHEREAS, said notices served upon those certificated employees listed below advised them that they could request a hearing before the Governing Board to determine if there was cause for not reemploying them for the 2003-2004 school year and that if they failed to timely request a hearing, that failure would constitute the waiver of the right to a hearing, and his/her services would accordingly be terminated pursuant to the recommendation;

**WHEREAS**, various employees requested a hearing and certificated employee layoff proceedings accordingly have occurred pursuant to Sections 44955 and 44949 of the Education Code, with an Administrative Law Judge having held an evidentiary hearing and then submitting a proposed decision relating to those proceedings;

**WHEREAS**, on April 28 and 29, 2003, a hearing on the layoffs was conducted by an Administrative Law Judge pursuant to the California Administrative Procedure Act, and a proposed decision was rendered on May 6, 2003 and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has received and considered the proposed decision of the Administrative Law Judge in OAH Case No. L2003030132 and any arguments submitted by or on behalf of the parties regarding that proposed decision;

**WHEREAS**, the Education Code provides that this Board shall make the final determination as to the sufficiency of the cause and disposition;

**WHEREAS**, the particular kinds of services to be discontinued and reduced as referenced in Board Resolution No. 02-23 and No. 02-25 are each determined to be a particular kind of service within the meaning of Education Code Section 44955;

**WHEREAS**, the particular kinds of services referenced in Board Resolution No. 02-23 and 02-25 will be discontinued and reduced within the meaning of Education Code Section 44955 not later than the beginning of the 2003-2004 school year;

WHEREAS, the services of no permanent employee (or other employee) are being terminated, in whole or in part, while any probationary employee, or any other employee with less seniority is being retained to render a service which said permanent (or other) employee is certificated and competent to render, within the meaning of Education Code Section 44955(b); the individuals whose employment is being terminated, in whole or in part, are not certificated and competent (within the meaning of Education Code Section 44955) to render the service being performed by any employee with less seniority who is being retained;

**WHEREAS**, sufficient cause exists for the termination of up to 61.4 full-time equivalent certificated positions, and pursuant to and within the meaning of Education Code Section 44949, said cause relates to the welfare of the schools and the pupils thereof;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that this Board accepts the proposed decision of the Administrative Law Judge and adopts that proposed decision (a copy of which is attached) as the decision of this Board of Education;
