RE: REVIEW BOARD POLICY SERIES 3000, 6000, AND 7000

### DISCUSSION ITEM NO. D.01

It is recommended that the Board of Education review Board Policy Articles 3000 (Business and Non Instructional Operations), 6000 (Instruction), and 7000 (Facilities) for adoption at a subsequent Board of Education meeting. At that subsequent meeting, staff will recommended that the Board delete all current policies, administrative regulations in these articles and adopt those reviewed and recommended for Board adoption today and that these actions will be effective August 1, 2009.

### COMMENT:

The District embarked on a process of reviewing and updating all its policies, administrative regulations and related exhibits. It was agreed that California School Boards Association Board policies would serve as an example for that comparative review and in November a series of workshops were conducted with appropriate staff and a consultant from CSBA to review each District Policy, administrative regulation and exhibit along side those of CSBA and make recommended changes to the Board. Previous revisions made to policies that reflect the specific interests of SMMUSD have not been altered (as long as those revisions are compliant with state and federal law).

This is the second Board of Education meeting to discuss updated policies. A third meeting is yet to be scheduled to continue this process with Articles 0000 (Philosophies, Goals, Objectives, and Plans), and 1000 (Community Relations) will be discussed at the June 4 meeting. Articles 3000 (Business and Non-Instructional Operations) and 5000 (Students) will be discussed on June 10.

Additionally, staff recommended and the Board approved after the new policies are adopted they would be returned to CSBA for uploading to their computers and be linked to our web site for public and staff access and printing.

CSBA issues updates in March, July, and November of each year that reflect recent changes in Federal and state statue, law, Education Code and case law. When

received these changes will be reviewed and appropriate recommendations made to the board.

In this manner, the District can maintain its policies and administrative regulations that will keep the District in full compliance.

## Public Comments:

• Adam Baldwin, a member of the community, addressed the board regarding BP 6115 and the policy review process. Mr. de la Torre asked staff about community input regarding this policy review process. Mr. Cuneo replied that ad hoc communities can be established to help develop or review specific policies, but that the process being used tonight is more efficient for reviewing such a large number of policies. Mr. Snell reminded everyone that this information is online and the public has a thirty-day period to comment on the proposed changes. The board requested a press release be distributed announcing the public comment period for these policies.

Mr. Allen asked if there was a complaint procedure if someone suspected a teacher was in violation of this policy. Staff said there is a Complaint against Employee form and process.

Dr. Escarce suggested the board approve a list of Internet-based courses in the interim until the UC system releases an approved list. Dr. Chou indicated that proposed policies with online course language were pulled from previous board agendas, but the draft language will be brought back for first reading at the next board meeting.

## 7000 SERIES

## 7000(a)

The board asked what constitutes "major" in "Approve additions or major alterations to existing buildings." Mr. de la Torre suggested assigning a monetary threshold of \$10,000 (or some other appropriate amount) to determine a "major alteration." Ms. Pye suggested including technology upgrades as part of major upgrades. As a means of tracking how effective district efforts are at reaching out to historically-underrepresented groups and encouraging them to submit bids, Mr. de la Torre suggested adding the following language: "Monitor fairness and diversity of bids and contracts awarded to women- and minority-owned and local businesses by collecting related data on vendors/ contractors during the bidding process." Ms. Maez replied that this information could be provided on a voluntary level by potential vendors/contractors, but that staff would consult further with counsel. Ms. Pye and Dr. Escarce suggested considering the language of AR 7150(b)(4) for a model.

<u>Updated Policies (little or no changes): 7310</u> Ms. Maez explained that this is a minor change and will come back for approval on the consent agenda.
