Upcoming board meetings in May:

• Thurs., May 20, 2021, 5:30 p.m. (regular meeting via Zoom)

The board discussed the following:

- Educational Services presented information on the purpose of student assessments, the types of assessments used and how the data is used to inform instruction, the lead data gathered, and key findings and next steps. Staff also discussed summer school.
- The superintendent provided his regular COVID-19 update.
- Staff presented information on the textbook adoption for middle school science. The item will return for action on May 20, 2021.

The board took action on the following:

- The board adopted a resolution honoring Asian/Pacific American Heritage Month. The resolution highlights the ingenuity, perseverance, and achievement of the Asian/Pacific American community, recognizing the contributions of the Asian/Pacific immigrants who have come to America to discover the promise of our nation and realize their dreams.
- The board adopted a resolution honoring California Day of the Teacher, which is May 12 this year. The resolution underscores the importance of the teaching profession.
- The board heard public comments and took action on the Measure R CPI-U adjustment.
- The board approved Chorus as a course for middle schools.
