### The board discussed the following:

• The superintendent presented information on what budget reductions had been made at the district office in recent years, what reductions are planned for 2020-21, and the strategic plans being examined to realign our district office resources moving forward.

#### The board took action on the following:

- The board adopted a resolution recognizing the dedicated service of our district's classified employees. This year, Week of the Classified School Employee is May 17-23.
- The board adopted a resolution recognizing National School Nurses Day: May 6, 2020.
  It honors the work school nurses do each day to care for the entire school population, especially the most vulnerable.
- The board adopted a course approval for middle school: Peer Connections. The board also adopted a list of course approvals for high school: Peer Connections, U.S. History (American Cultures and Ethnic Studies), Graphic Design 3, Aerospace Engineering, Photography 3, AP Computer Science Principles, Professional Dance/Choreography (I, II, and III), Physics of the Universe, and Chemistry in the Earth System.
- The board adopted the 3<sup>rd</sup> budget revisions for the 2019-20 budget. Attached was a mutli-year projection that included budget reductions discussed earlier in the meeting.
- The board authorized a one-time exemption allowing PTAs in Malibu to raise funds for staff and programs at SMMUSD schools in Malibu. The PTAs will donate those funds to our district through Malibu LEAD, The Shark Fund, or another entity. Meanwhile, a new centralized fundraising entity in Malibu will be established moving forward.
