



DUAL ENROLLMENT POLICIES AND REQUIREMENTS

Dual Enrollment permits high school students the opportunity to enroll in Santa Monica College courses that take place at the high school site for educational enrichment. The purpose of the program is to provide “advanced scholastic,” “educational enrichment opportunities for a limited number of eligible pupils” as defined by Education Code, Section 48800 and 76002.

Policies and Requirements:

1. Dual Enrollment students must have completed the 8th grade or equivalent prior to the beginning of the semester or term they plan to participate in the program.
2. Dual Enrollment students must complete all forms with their high school counselor who will help select classes that meet their educational needs. Students will only be permitted to register for classes that their counselor approves.
3. Students must meet any English, Math and/or other course prerequisites.
4. Dual Enrollment students must have the signature of a parent or legal guardian authorizing the student’s participation in the program.
5. Effective Spring 2015, participating students are exempted from enrollment fees and non-resident tuition if they are physically attending a high school in California. Out-of-state resident and nonimmigrant students (e.g. F1 & F2 visas) do not qualify for the fee exception.
6. Students are limited to six units, or two classes, per semester.
7. Students will not be allowed to take courses in subject areas that the student previously received below a C grade (most recent attempt), whether taken at the college or high school level.
8. Dual Enrollment students will not be allowed to enroll in any physical education courses.
9. Credit courses are COLLEGE courses and will remain on the student’s permanent record even if the secondary school uses the coursework as High School Credit. All coursework taken will appear on the student’s Santa Monica College transcript.
10. Courses offered are at the college level and instructors will teach at that level. Students may be exposed to and be involved in discussions of mature subjects.
11. Santa Monica College is not responsible for the supervision of minor students anywhere on campus outside of the classroom setting. Faculty are not expected to wait with students until their ride arrives. At times, classes may be dismissed early.
12. Dual Enrollment students must adhere to all college policies on course requirements, attendance, dates and deadlines, and any other applicable policies and procedures including the Student Code of Conduct. See college catalog or schedule of classes for policies.
13. Students must act on their own behalf. Parents, guardians, relatives, or friends of Santa Monica College students are not permitted to enroll, drop, or add classes on behalf of the student. Students giving parents their ID and password are in violation of the Computer Use Policy and may be subject to disciplinary action or denial of access to the student portal. The same prohibition applies to requesting transcripts. Student records are protected under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). Therefore, SMC will not discuss or release student information to anyone, including parents, without the student’s signed written consent.
14. Dual Enrollment students may participate in extra-curricular activities only at the high school level.
15. F-1 and F-2 visa students are not eligible to enroll as a Dual Enrollment student.
