For **every** reading log turned in with 6 reading hours completed:

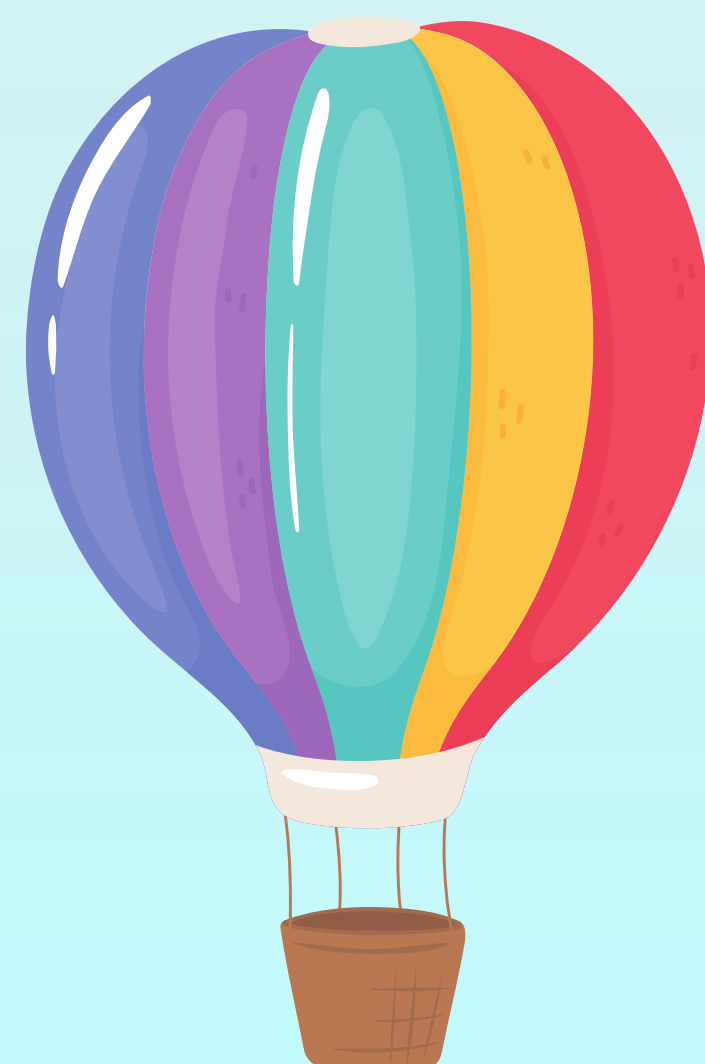
- Students will receive a small prize (e.g., pencil, eraser) that will be distributed weekly to each class

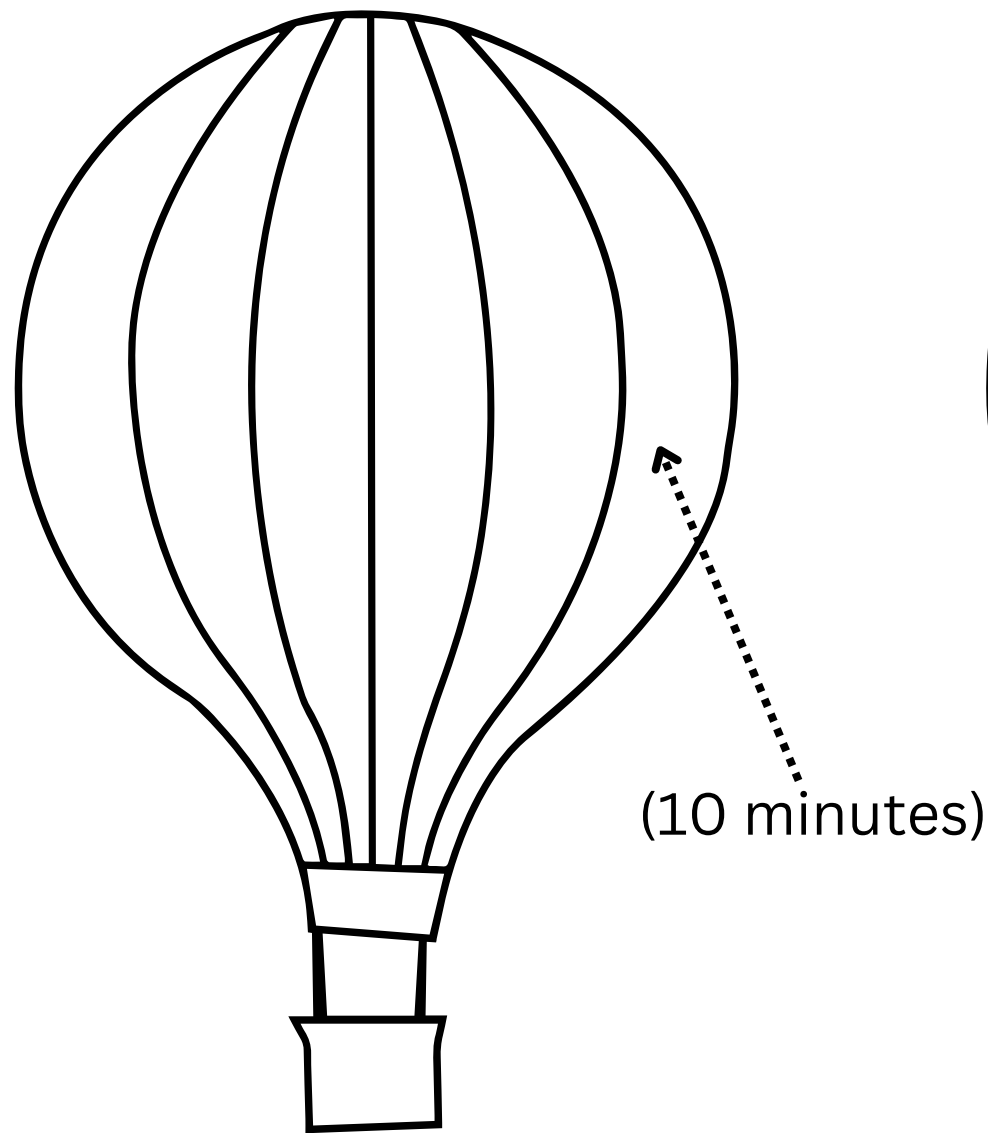

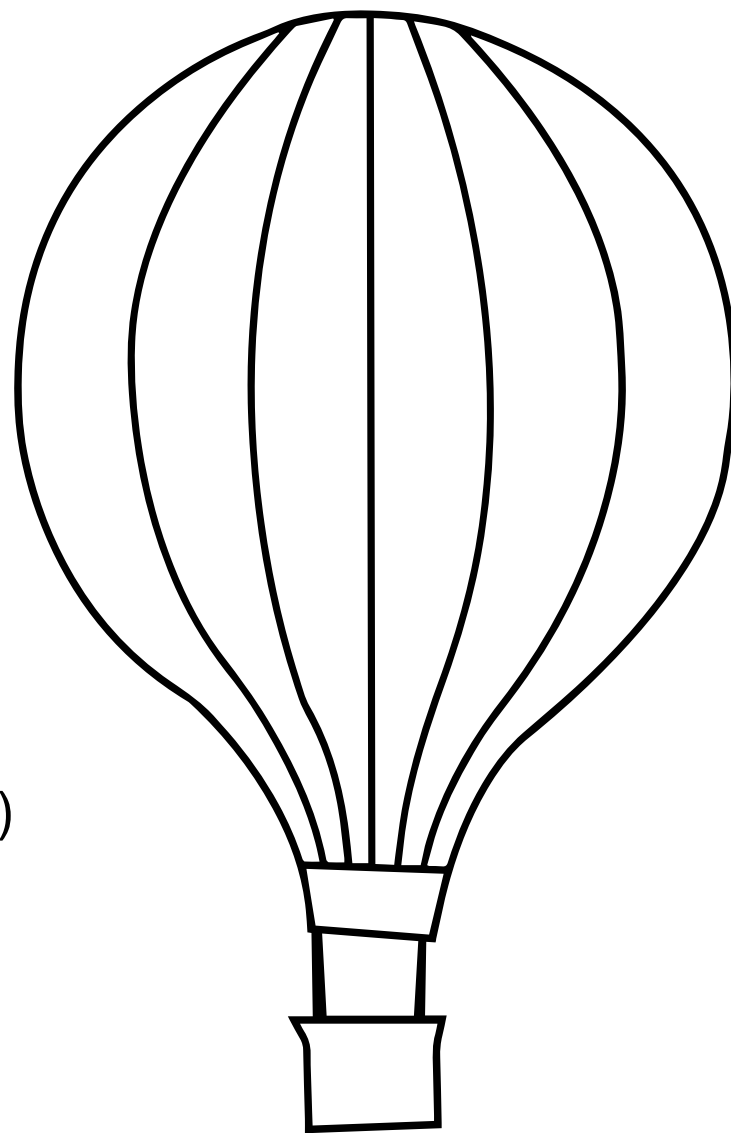
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2023 READ-A-THON: STUDENT READING LOG

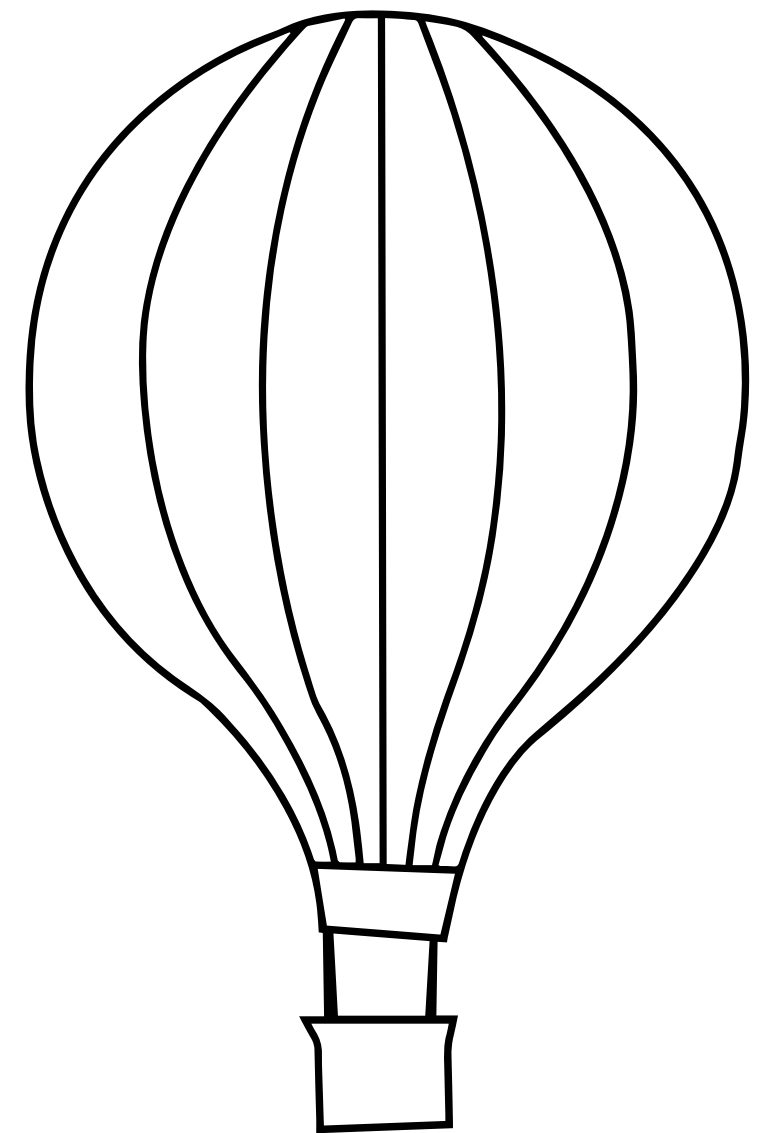
