Discussion of how to get parents to participate in donating/

3.) SLT-Board Presentation (Walk Through)

Lynda shared who attended the walk through Roosevelt. They went through a classroom at each grade level. They noticed themes across the classrooms. They noticed teachers ask questions and students search for the answers, they are not just fed the answers. Classrooms were consistent and coherent in their instruction. It was noticed that there was vertical alignment within the grade levels.

Kitty shared about Cotsen grants and going to TC for the past 14 years.

TC was here in December. All went well. We're moving to a new model of teachers choosing a focus to work on. It was shared that at the last TC workshop, 5th grade changed their persuasive essay topics and found all of the articles for students to use as reference for their pros/cons.

UCLA developers will be here at the end of the month to work on the Choral Counting/counting collections.

TC will be back in February/March to work on the next round of professional development.

4.) SLT committee will be developing the PD calendar for next year in the upcoming months. They will be using data to drive our professional development.
