Site Prep

- All demo except the South Gym is complete
- All shoring is installed and bulk excavation is complete

DSA

- Plans submitted to DSA in May '21
- Received back-check in November '21
- Resubmitted to DSA after Value Engineering
- The final submittal was made on 3/21/22
- Architects currently reviewing back check comments with DSA
- Approval anticipated by mid-May

Construction

- The GMP contract (guaranteed max price) was awarded to McCarthy on 3/22/22
- Previous awards made for some long-lead-time trades to limit potential delays (included in \$120M)
- Anticipate start of construction in May 2022,
- 24-month construction period to final sign off May 2024



- Landscape between business and history completed and open -- included trees from nursery- to date all trees in the nursery have been used.
- 86 new 48-gallon trees have been brought for Phase 3. Nursery will be expanded along the football field will be planted in the spring of 2024 before construction completion
- Contracts awarded to Inspector of Record and Laboratory of Record for materials and special inspections for steel fabrication in Arizona
- The team is currently working through RFIs, shop drawings/submittals; scheduling; in preparation for the start of the project
- FF&E started the review of the procurement process
