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

School Safety and Improvement Projects

Thanks to generous voter support, local bond measures funded urgent repairs and upgrades to existing facilities to ensure the health and safety of students, including:

- Modernized school security, including cameras, intruder protection systems and fire/emergency alarms
- Updated classroom windows, doors and flooring
- Replaced aging HVAC systems for clean air in classrooms
- Updated ADA accessibility to provide proper access for those with disabilities
- Added 21st-century classrooms, science labs and school libraries, designed to support high-quality instruction
- Upgrading Samohi's arts and physical education facilities
- Upgrading or replacing failing, deteriorating portable classroom trailers at elementary schools
- Upgrading aging shop classrooms for modern, hands-on programs that teach today's skills
