Malibu High Groundbreaking

The District held a groundbreaking ceremony for the new Malibu High School project in October 2023. This is an exciting step towards providing state-of-the-art classrooms and school facilities to ensure all Malibu students have access to the best possible educational opportunities.

The new Malibu High School is designed to support 21st-century learning. The entire building will be treated as a learning facility, allowing students to learn in an array of indoor and outdoor classrooms that support high-quality instruction. It is a high school designed for the Malibu student and community.

The new Malibu High School is scheduled to open by 2026.

Improving Aging School Facilities

We're eager to kick off the next round of improvements for Malibu schools to ensure all students have access to safe and modern schools.

These projects include:

- Improving safety and security measures, including systems to provide emergency power
- Assessments of Malibu and Webster Elementary Schools to support quality education
- Constructing an Olympic size pool and swim center
- Completing Malibu Middle School with a new building

While the new Malibu High School project has broken ground, many projects are left to be done. The District is currently evaluating options to complete the next step of repairs and upgrades at all Malibu schools.
