Principal's Report

 Next week, Core Family Forums will take place in the evening on Tues. (for Core 1 and Core 2) and Thurs. (for Core 3 and 4). It will also be an opportunity to meet new staff members. We're on track to move back to the 5th Street Campus next year. TK will be added and we will grow (double) Core 1. Jessica is encouraging everyone to take a school tour to get to know our school better and share this invitation/news with others.

Student Reports

Core 4 shared what's going on in class. In 8th grade math, the students are deciding between Algebra and 8th grade math. In Humanities, they're reading Diary of a Part-time Indian and studying the Americas. In Science, they're building pull-toys and robots and learning coding. Miles to Go will start whenever Jonathan, the teacher, is feeling better. He will share his childhood experiences with drugs and the impact drugs will have on students' lives.
