Reviewed SMASH Safety Plan including COVID compliant screening, containment and cleaning protocols. SMASH Safety Plan will be presented to SMMUSD Board of Ed in January 2021. All updated SMMUSD COVID related information and procedures can be found at https://www.smmusd.org/domain/2885

Site council is considered the SMASH safety team since it is a small school site. District website has COVID information that is updated as more data is available. A response guide is available for how to respond if someone (student or staff) is displaying symptoms of COVID. Isolation on campus is the hallway between the front office building and the library (covered corridor). Nurse Kelsey (part-time) and health office specialists (2) will be on campus and available to determine if isolation is necessary. Funding is earmarked for the additional health office specialist during the pandemic. There is information for when someone has been sent home, but this information is "premature" because this is being changed by the health department weekly. Free testing sites are listed in District information, yet no budgetary planning or arrangements are being considered for onsite school testing. Approved cleaning products that are effective and considered less toxic are listed on the website. PPE is listed by type of staff member as well.
