PARENT

As a parent, I understand that it is my responsibility to:

1. Ensure that my student places academic achievement as the highest priority.
2. Ensure that my student shows respect for teammates, opponents, officials and coaches.
3. Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials.
4. Ensure that my student exhibits fair play, sportsmanship and proper conduct on and off the playing field.
5. I will maintain a high level of safety awareness while spectating events on any campus.
6. I will refrain from the use of profanity, vulgarity and other offensive language and gestures at all CIF and District sporting events.
7. I will adhere to the established rules and standards of the game to be played or set by any school campus.
8. Ensure and discuss with my student to know and follow all state, section and school athletic rules and regulations as they pertain to eligibility and sports participation.
9. Discuss with my student the importance of the CIF "Win with character, lose with dignity" theme.

Communication expectations for parents to coaches after the game or sporting event:

- Parents are encouraged to offer praise or positive feedback directly after a game or sporting event with the coach
- As a parent, you are allowed to follow up with decisions that impact your child or your child's involvement with the team.
 - Ensure you make a request to speak with the coach, this request MUST be made with the Athletic Coordinator as well. Prefer a text and email to the Athletic Coordinator
 - 24 hours must clear before the parent, coach & Athletic Coordinator connect. Or wait until the next business day. Text & email are still expected to move forward.
