Update on funds that were discussed in January minutes, said additional funding is actually already allocated by Muir's SSGC last year. Those funds of \$196,000 5 IAs and a Reading Interventionist which are currently working at WRLC.

Only left over funding is \$3k for parent engagement and \$15k for supplemental instruction

46.5 hours of aide time is funded by district.

That is .5 hours over the allotted time that we can cover through Title 1 funds

K. Alexander motioned to approve the transfer of the IA's funded by Title 1 Funds to the Foundation funding because we had unfilled positions in this budget line item from already allocated funds. Mark Miller seconded. Motion carried.

Principal Daruty shared data from the SIPSA about testing data, that indicates that math scores are dropping. That coupled with staff and council observations math will be a focus for next year's SIPSA.

This was followed by an in depth look at the CAASP and STAR testing data collected both last school year and this year.
