I. Meeting Called to Order:

Meeting was called to order at 4:16 p.m.

II. Minutes:

At 4:22 a Motion was made by Liz Kok for January 2021 minutes to be accepted. Seconded by Gina Engler. The aye's have it and the motion has passed.

A. Data Report (Elizabeth) - 10 mins

1. Winter Data Reading: Presented by Daniela Wiener: The validity of the data has come into question since the children cannot be monitored while taking assessments as well as they could in person. The teachers, however, feel that the data verifies what they expected. Results of the assessments were presented to the Site Council via slide presentation. Testing restraints, reading volume, text complexity are all factors that had an impact on results, especially in the older grades. The students in 5th grade showed they performed better on the Fast bridge test rather than the F&P. 4th grade showed level improvement year over year. 3rd grade decreased the bottom tier numbers and a small decrease in the number of students in the highest tier and a small decrease in the number of students maintaining growth. The F&P and Fast bridge assessments show a big variance in results. 2nd grade is hard to assess as they take this assessment very early in their English reading. For Spanish assessments in 2nd grade there were improvements. 1st grade: there are 1 on 1 assessments for Spanish. F&P showed improvement in Spanish decoding/reading. Kindergarten was assessed on letter names and letter sounds and showed improvement from Fall.

The implications of this data are that we should continue with Tier III intervention and grade level standards should be taught, increase the number of books students are reading and provide more impromptu assessments.

2. Winter Data Math: 4th grade has a pretty big slide in kids in the top tier. 3rd grade showed an improvement in the lower tier kids, but the rest were steady. 2nd decreased tier 3 students.

Implications: Continue to support students performing below but consider ways to lift the ceiling for students exceeding.

B. SPSA Budget Review:

We followed the district protocol for how to create a DL Plus plan. Here is the sequence:

1. Site Council discussed ideas
2. Safety Committee (including reps from Site Council, PTA, and nurses) developed nuts and bolts of safety
 - a. Plan was presented to public
 - b. Approved by Site Council
2. SLT and FAC met to develop the content of the plan
 - a. A plan was developed (1 afternoon per week per grade level)
 - b. Public hearings in both languages on this plan to get feedback (105 different people)
 - c. Presentation at ELAC
 - d. Plan was taken to the Superintendent's meeting (along with reps from Site Council, PTA, teacher, FAC)
 2. SLT and FAC met again to revise considering feedback from all of the groups above
- a. Two models were developed
 - i. Full day model
 - ii. 2 - half day models
2. Change made by state requirements (CDC) so only 2-day model is feasible.
3. District and teacher union agreed that schools will reopen 15 days after vaccines are available - tentatively March 15th.
 - a. Model presented to staff
 - b. Model presented to Site Council
 - c. Model will be presented to parents
4. Muir, McKinley, Franklin, Edison have similar plans
