Meeting Called to Order:

Meeting was called to order at 4:08 p.m.

Minutes: At 4:23pm a Motion was made by Lori Orum for November 2020 minutes be accepted. Seconded by Geralyn. The aye's have it and the motion has passed.

Reports:

- A. School/District Report (Lori) - 20 mins
 - 1. **District News**
 - a. **Reopening plans:** School Board meeting tomorrow night (December 17) where the plan will be presented. Dr. Drati will be recommending the distance learning Plus model due to the parent survey results. (At this point Lori Orum shared the Survey results via Zoom)
 - b. **Tutoring Support:** The district did get funds to put together a tutoring program for at risk students. 2 /30-minute sessions a week for each child. Not a lot of families signed up their kids. Challenges are that the time period of 2-4pm was difficult due to other activities and parents not wanting kids on zoom longer. The goal would be to use the district funds/tutoring for now and see how it works and then move to use our funds for tutoring.
 - a. **School News:** Recorrido: Edi is moving form Michoacán to Panama! 10 minutes of the movie night on Friday will be devoted to talking about Recorrido!
- B. Data Report (Elizabeth) - 20 mins
 - 1. **Reclassification of ELs: 4 criteria: Must score a 4/4 on the ELPAC, Meet or Exceed grade level (ELA, CAASPP, FastBridge/PSAT), Parental opinion and consultation, and teacher evaluation.** 5 students were reclassified.
 - 2. **IAB results:** ELA is for 3-5th grade, Math is for 1-5th grade. (Next assessments are Fastbridge and F&P's in January and IAB's in February) Results of IAB's from Fall were presented by Elizabeth Ipiña (Link to results imbedded in Minutes pink text) NOTE: Further discussions continued regarding Math for 4th and 5th graders appearing to be an issue. English learners are struggling more in math than non-English learners. According to the district numbers, this is a trend across the district, not just at Edison. We also need to wait for the second set of data points from the January assessments.

- A. SPSA update (Lori)- 20 mins **3 errors were found in the Objectives section and are Proposed as noted below:**

Overall ELA in 2018-19: 71% (Grades 3-5) proficient or advanced
 Overall Math in 2018-19: 60% (Grades 3-5) proficient or advanced
 Overall Writing Claims in 2018- 19 (Grades 3-5) 94% above or near with 39% scoring above
 Overall ELA in 2020-2021: 74% (Grades 3-5) proficient or advanced
 Overall Math in 2020-2021 - 65% (Grades 3-5) proficient of advanced
 Writing claims in 2020-2021: 90% will continue to score Above or Near with 43% scoring Above.

Expected Outcome

CAASPP ELA and Math Scores

CAASPP Writing Claim Scores

In 2018-19, 42% of ELs scored proficient or advanced in ELA In 2018-19, 24% of ELs scored proficient or advanced in Math In 2018-19, 83% of ELs scored above or near grade level on their writing claims.

In 2020-2021, at least 47% of ELs in 3-4-5th grades will score proficient or advanced in ELA.

In 2020-2021, at least 30% of ELs in 3-4-5 grades will score proficient or advanced in Math.

In 2020-2021, at least 85% of ELs in grades 3-4-5 will score above or near grade level in their writing claims.

At 5:30 Gina Engler made a motion to approve the above corrections to the SPSA and Felipe Martinez seconded. The aye's have it and the motion has passed.

A. Elections (Elizabeth) - 10 mins: Liz Kok and Jose Cervantes are coming up on the end of their two year term and elections will need to be held to select their replacements. It was corrected by Jose that the terms for these two would be extended through the school year per our January 2020 meeting minutes as noted below:

"Election of new members should be moved to the beginning of the school year rather than the beginning of the calendar year due to the change of due date for the SPSA. With this change we would need to move the meetings to the last Wednesday of the month rather than the second Wednesday of the month."

After further discussion it was decided that the Bylaws should be amended to reflect this and presented with this change at our next meeting.
