- Hazel Health: any insurance or no insurance, trying to keep counseling at school
- Other interns: any insurance or no insurance
- Youth Resource Team YRT
- SMPD Diversion Program
- Children Youth and Family Collaborative: for students in foster care or homeless
- Wrap-around services through special education
- FSP The Children's Full Service Partnership program is a unique intensive in-home mental health service program for children ages 0-15 and their families: extreme cases
- Off-Campus Support: St. Johns, Family Services of Santa Monica, Our House, Edelman Mental Health Services, CLARE/Matrix
