**Important Communication Regarding  
Your Medical Benefits**

Dear SMMUSD Retiree,

I am writing to inform you of a change to the District’s medical benefits program. Specifically, the District is changing the entity that serves as the District’s medical benefits purchasing pool. Effective, January 1, 2023, the District will join Self-Insured Schools of California (“SISC”) and will no longer be a member of the California Public Employees Retirement System (“CalPERS”) (medical benefits portion only). SISC will serve as the purchaser of the District’s medical benefit options. This change to SISC was recommended by the District’s Joint Committee on Health and Welfare Benefits (“Committee”) and approved by our bargaining/employee groups: SMMCTA, SEIU and SMMASA. The District’s move to SISC serves the long-term interests of employees, including retired employees, by maintaining affordability and quality of the medical benefits available to employees and their families.

You are receiving this communication because you are a retired employee from SMMUSD who participates, or is eligible to participate, in the District’s medical benefits program as an Early Retiree (under age 65, non-Medicare) (“Early Retiree”).

**All Early Retirees must complete and return to the District an enrollment packet to continue to participate in the District’s medical benefits program as an Early Retiree.**

Next Steps

1. Review all included materials.
2. Select one plan and complete the enrollment form:
  - a. SISC III PPO and HMO Enrollment Form
  - b. Kaiser Permanente Enrollment Form
3. Return the completed enrollment form to the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District on or before **November 18, 2022**. Mail or hand-delivery is acceptable.
