# A Message from Principal Schellenberg:

This week included some profound experiences for our Middle School students. The grade level activities with HumanUtopia provided our students a safe place to explore answers to the question, "Who Am I?"

We are grateful for Mr. Graham Moore from HumanUtopia who spent three full days with our middle school students. Graham talked about all of the events in our lives that make us who we are - including both the great things and the tough things. At one point, each grade level listened to Graham talk about the disparaging things we hear from others that "fill up our trash can" with negativity. Students had the opportunity to share some of the things said to them - hurtful, impactful comments. Graham was so skilled in building up the students who courageously shared - then he flipped it to allow for students who have made insulting comments to others to acknowledge, apologize and commit to moving forward differently. During the afternoon, students were paired up with other students they never choose to speak with to share details from their life, their hopes and dreams.

Our three days with HumanUtopia will have a positive impact on our school culture and community. As a school, we will follow up with students to try to keep this momentum going. HumanUtopia offers additional student programs we may be interested in exploring in the coming years.

**ENROLLMENT FOR 2024-2025:** Enrollment for the 2024-2025 school year for new families is open! If you have friends, neighbors, colleagues with children (who live in the MMS boundary) interested in joining our Malibu Middle School community or any of our Malibu schools, please have them email the registrars, for MMMS that is Beth Soloway at <a href="mailto:bsoloway@smmusd.org">bsoloway@smmusd.org</a>. If they do not live in the MMS boundary, they must first apply for an inter-district permit which be available soon on the school and district website.

**VOLUNTEER TRAININGS:** Interested in volunteering on campus, during the school day in any capacity? Then you must be processed and cleared as a Level 1 volunteer which includes completing volunteer packet, TB questionnaire, and attending an inperson training. The next Parent Volunteer Trainings (mainly for Friendly Faces) will be offered VIA ZOOM on **Friday, February 2**<sup>nd</sup> at 10:00 am, and in person on **Friday, March 15**<sup>th</sup> after the POMS meeting (approximately 11:00 am.) **GUM/TRASH:** We have seen an increase in the amount of gum thrown on the ground or stuck on furniture and an increase in the amount of trash being left on tables and the ground. In grades 6-12, it is not unreasonable to expect students to be able to put their gum into the trash cans and to put their trash into the trash cans. We are asking for your help in reminding your child the importance of doing so. As a community, it is all of our responsibility to keep our campus clean, safe, and well presented. We have new buildings, new furniture in most rooms, new sidewalks that are getting destroyed simply because a student can't walk 3 feet and put their gum in the trash can. We need to care for our campus better and care for our environment better, the ocean is yards away and yet kids leave trash for the winds or birds to carry to the ocean. We have one daytime custodian - he is not employed to pick up student trash. It is the student's responsibility to throw away their trash.
