GUM: We have seen an increase in the amount of gum thrown on the ground or stuck on furniture. In grades 6-12, it is not unreasonable to expect students to be able to put their gum into the trash cans. We are asking your help in reminding your child the importance of doing so. As a community, it is all of our responsibility to keep our campus clean, safe, and well presented. We have new buildings, new furniture in most rooms, new sidewalks that are getting destroyed simply because a student can't walk 3 feet and put their gum in the trash can. It is not OK.

TRASH: Similarly, we have seen an increase in the amount of trash being left on tables and the ground. In grades 6-12, it is not unreasonable to expect students to be able to put their trash into the trash cans. We are asking your help in reminding your child the importance of doing so. As a community, it is all of our responsibility to keep our campus clean, safe, and well presented. We need to care for our campus better and care for our environment better, the ocean is yards away and yet kids leave trash for the winds or birds to carry to the ocean. We have one daytime custodian, he is not employed to pick up student trash. It is the student's responsibility to throw away their trash.
