Throughout that day we went classroom to classroom but did nothing more than watch the TV news. So many images that likely weren't smart for us as "kids" to watch in real time or on reply.

But on that day, we made a promise to never forget. In that spirit, I have often done lessons with my students using the following two resources. Beyond the terrible images, we also remember the many heroes, the helpers and Mr. Fred Rogers used to remind us to look for. We also remember the genuine sense of community, patriotism, and common humanity on September 12 and the subsequent weeks, months, years. Feel free to use these resources in your own discussion with students about your own experiences and memories from 9-11-01. Stories of courage, compassion, community...

MEDICATION ON CAMPUS: No student is to carry in his/her possession at any time either prescription medication or over-the-counter medication. All medication must be checked in with the school nurse and administered by a school official following the written guidelines of a physician. Also, the use of crutches or any other mobility devices at school requires a written order from the physician that includes the diagnosis & length of time the device is needed.

BOTTLE FILLERS: MHS has three FloWater bottle filling stations on campus. Encourage your student to bring a refillable water bottle and to drink lots of water.

AFTER SCHOOL TUTORING HAS STARTED!: After school math tutoring is available in the Library with Mr. Corrigan or Ms. Seikali, Monday through Thursday from 3:45 – 4:45 pm.

BREAKFAST/LUNCH REMINDERS: Breakfast is available 8:00-8:20am M-Fri. Lunch is served daily (11:45-12:15, 12:10-12:40, 10:50-11:20 depending on day). Students should be prepared to show ID. Please help remind your students to be patient, keep hands to themselves, and noise level down while in the cafeteria serving space...or at all times would also be great.

THIS WEEK AT MHS:

DIAGNOSTIC TESTING: Between **September 5 and September 15**, all students will complete diagnostic assessments in reading and math. These local measurements are referred to as Star Renaissance tests and will be administered for diagnostic purposes in the fall and two subsequent times throughout the year as a progress monitoring tool.
