FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL: The first day of school is **Thursday, August 22**nd. Students should arrive between 8:10am-8:25am for an 8:30am start of school. Official schedules will be distributed to high school students in the high school quad. Even if students believe there is an error in their schedule, they are to attend all the classes shown on their official schedule until it can be resolved with their counselor. This is a REGULAR period 1-6 Day with dismissal for students in grades 9-12 at 3:30 pm. Do not arrive before 3:30 pm for pick up.

SECOND DAY OF SCHOOL: Unlike previous years, **Friday, August 23rd** is also a **Regular Schedule Day** with dismissal at 3:30 pm. Students will attend periods 1-6.

UPCOMING EVENTS:

START OF AM/PM PE: The first day of AMPM PE class is **Monday, August 26th.** AMPM PE class meets every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 7:15-8:25. Class starts at 7:15. Parents should drop off students in the pool lot by 7:10, students will meet their PE teacher on the blacktop.
