SCHOOL NEWS AND INFORMATION:

PARKING/PICK UP AND DROP OFF PROCEDURES: As we all work to ensure student safety and to keep traffic moving, please remember some of these helpful tips:

- Always pull as far forward as possible and continue to pull forward as space is made available.
- Your student will walk to you. If the car can move, keep moving.
