

Building Tomorrow's Future: Roosevelt Elementary School New Library and Early Childhood Learning Building

Construction for the new library and early childhood learning building for Roosevelt Elementary School is officially underway.





Underground electrical work was completed, including saw cutting the hardscape and performing directional boring beneath it. Concrete curbs and footings were poured for the temporary play area in the courtyard. Construction trailers were delivered and installed, and the final portable building, along with Building K, was demolished and removed from the site.

The project design encompasses the creation of a fresh, inviting entry sequence, along with the construction of a new library building and library garden situated prominently at the front of the school on Montana Avenue.

Adjacent to the library, there will be three state-of-the-art transitional kindergarten (TK) classrooms and four kindergarten classrooms, accompanied by teacher collaboration areas and age-appropriate play yards. The building will be approximately 17,000 square feet and will seamlessly

integrate with the historic courtyards of the adjacent buildings while preserving Roosevelt's cherished community identity.

New Library and Early Childhood Learning Building

In preparation for construction, several classrooms were relocated. A temporary TK and kindergarten play yard was created in the historical courtyard. Portable classrooms were refurbished, and an additional portable restroom has been located near the bungalows.
